



Mosaic Mitten

Activity Type: Arts & Crafts

Focuses: Naming/identifying colors

Trace or draw a mitten shape on a piece of construction paper or tag board. Cut out the middle leaving a ½ inch wide border around the entire mitten. Place a piece of clear contact paper on the table sticky side up. Put the mitten outline down on the contact paper. Give your child pre-cut smallish squares of tissue paper in bright colors to place on the sticky surface. As your child places the squares ask them to name the colors they choose. You could also put the colors into a bowl and ask your child to find certain color to place on the contact paper next. When the mitten is full place another piece of clear contact paper over the top. Trim around the edges of the mitten. Hang your mosaic mitten on a window or sliding glass door.
